PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST:

The competition for delectable drawings will serve as a great focus point for families to talk about the value of food, as well as an opportunity for kids to produce and inspire others to reduce food waste, benefiting the world one drawing at a time. Students have traditionally used drawings to express themselves, expressing their originality, inventiveness, and joy in learning about the world around them. For the first time in **India, Drawing Competition for World Hunger Day- 28th May 2023**, we would like to give all our children the possibility to express themselves and their feelings about this outstanding event and to become a part of the exclusive **“INDIA'S LARGEST ART COMPETITION 2023”**. The registration money collected from this Drawing competition will be positively used to reduce hunger for animals and to feed homeless people who cannot afford to buy their meals for a day. **100%** of the proceeds will be going to **Feed@100**. This contest will aim to attempt the **Guinness World Records**.

THEME - Don't waste food (Same theme for all five categories)

STUDENTS CATEGORY WISE

- Category 1 – Class I – III
- Category 2 – Class IV – V
- Category 3 – Class VI – VIII
- Category 4 – Class IX– XII
- Category 5 – College level (18 years – 21 years)

Eligibility

Participants must be between **5 years to 21** years to enter this Contest.

How to Register?

- Entry fee is Rs.100 only (Your registration is 100% going for a cause).
- The registration will be online– Individual students can also participate with the help of parents or teachers or a school/college can collectively register on behalf of the students.
- The Details of the students who participated can be sent in an excel sheet to the organizing committee by the school, college and art schools management if there is participation in bulk.

Guidelines:

1. Only one entry per registration.
2. Competition is open to all schools/Art Institutes/Special Schools across India.
3. Participants' artwork should not be smaller than 8' X 12' (21cm X 29.7 cm) – A4 Size
4. The submitted entries of the art sheet must have a high-resolution digital image of the entry (jpeg format, minimum 300dpi and not exceeding 3 MB).
5. The Art Sheet should be filled with the Name, Class with section and School name of the participant.
6. The art can be created using freehand, pencil, sketch pens, crayons (including water-soluble, pastel, graphite, charcoal pencils).
7. The artwork should not be retouched or graphically represented.
8. Entries will be shortlisted and judged at the Regional level, Zonal level and National level.
9. The Winners will be awarded with the cash prize, Medal, and E-Certificates
10. The core judging committee would verify the artworks before the winners are finalized.
11. All the participants will receive the e-certificate with the record mentioned after
12. The submitted entries which do not follow these rules will be subjected to disqualification.
13. The winning National level participants, schools and colleges will be invited to the Valedictory Ceremony followed by the PRESS MEET.
14. Any school/college with over **500+ Registrations** will be given - memento, certificate, sponsored food packets, press article, and **1 free workshop** to the school / College by Eminent artist.

MODE OF SUBMISSION:

- After the registration, the participants will receive information regarding the submission via Email.
- The schools/ Colleges can collectively submit the entries to their respective coordinators.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

A selection committee will review artwork submissions based on the following criteria:

- **Interpretation of the theme**
- **Creativity**
- **Originality**

COPYRIGHT LAW:

- Any artwork that depicts copyrighted images will be rejected. For example, no artworks depicting characters from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted. All artworks must be original ideas and created entirely by the student.
- The organizers would hold the right to reject any National award-winning entry if it is found to be violating any rules or condition of the activity during the verification and replace it with the shortlisted entry.
- The entries selected in the final judging will be announced ONLINE & PRESS Release.
